



## ADMISSIONS POLICY

### Admissions

All children may start school in the September of the school year in which their fifth birthday falls.

Applications for places in school for children beginning their Reception year should be made to the Local Authority by 15<sup>th</sup> January of the preceding school year. This should be done online at:

The Local Authority will rank all applications against the Lincolnshire County Council Admissions Policy criteria and parents will receive the highest ranked offer possible on 16<sup>th</sup> April 2025. Unsuccessful applicants will be informed of the reason for not being offered a place and that they have the right to make an independent appeal. Parents do have the right to accept a place for the September of the admissions year but defer their child's entry into school until the term after their child's fifth birthday. The place will be held open for the child. The published admissions number for our school is 30.

Parents are invited to contact school to discuss any concerns they may have regarding their child starting school here. A number of pre-school visits are arranged for the children in the term before they are due to start and parents will also have the opportunity to meet with many of the school staff including the Reception class teacher. A further meeting will also be arranged during June in order to facilitate a smooth and happy transition into school for all.
