Our new Absence & Attendance Policy is on the school website. Please take the time to read through it and acquaint yourself with the information it contains.

Whole school attendance for a state primary school is expected to be above **95%**. We are looking for every child at St Anne's Primary School to achieve 90% or above attendance and ideally 95% or above.

Absences & Illness

Please can all absences be reported at the school office via telephone, email or parentmail. Please **do not** send absence messages directly to teachers via Class Dojo. If your child is unwell please remember to keep them off school for **48 hours** after the last episode of sickness/diarrhoea to ensure a full recovery and prevent passing on infections. Please be conscious of the effect of passing on infections to other children and staff in school. Thank you.
