Uniform

If you are starting to think about your child's uniform for September, please find our uniform dress code attached to assist. Please note our primary colours are navy and grey - not black. Please note PE t-shirts were changed to navy last September. Trainers should be black - white are not acceptable. Children will continue to come to school dressed in their PE kit on PE days. Please ensure that all items of uniform are clearly labelled.

School Office

Please note the school office is open from 8.30am - 3.30pm (closed from 1-2pm) each day, for any queries you may have whether in person, by phone or email. All monies must be handed into the office not to a member of staff at the start or end of the day. Messages for teachers can be given to staff on the doors in the mornings. Thank you





Attendance

If you need to take your child out of school during term time, please remember to complete an Absence Form ahead of the absence taking place. Forms can be collected from the office or downloaded from our website. If the absence is for a doctor's, hospital or dental appointment a copy of the appointment letter should accompany the form.

Please note absences for any other time off school during term time (e.g. family holidays, birthdays, another family member's appointment etc) will be unauthorised unless the absence is considered 'exceptional'.

Any unauthorised absences of 5 school days, whether this is cumulative or over separate occasions within a 10-week period, will be subject to a fixed penalty fine being issued.

Free School Meals Entitlement (FSM)

If your financial situation has recently changed, you may find your child is entitled to Free School Meals based on benefits. Please visit [Free School Meals](#) to apply or contact the school office should you have any queries. Even if your child is in YR, Y1 or Y2 and gets lunch each day, it is still worth applying as you will be entitled to additional assistance in school.

Please note a letter was recently sent home regarding some additional changes to Free School Meal entitlement from September for those families claiming Universal Credit. Please do read this information and action where appropriate.

Absence & Illness

Please can all absences be reported at the school office via telephone, email or Parentmail (not via class dojo, adults in the playground or breakfast club staff). Please ensure you specify the nature of your child's illness, as 'unwell' or 'under the weather' are not sufficient to ensure our records are accurate. Please remember to keep children off school for 48 hours after the last episode of sickness or diarrhea to avoid passing on infections.

School Transport
