Material Hunt

Look around your house and make a list of the different objects you can see and what material they are made from. How many different types of material can you find? Can you describe the materials using some of the scientific vocabulary we are using in class?

Material classification

Find 10 different objects made from a range of materials. How can you group these objects thinking about the materials and scientific vocabulary? Use vocabulary such as hard, soft, dull, shiny, opaque and transparent.

Investigate Materials

Select 5 different materials such as paper, tissue, foil, fabric, sponge, plastic, cling film etc to test the absorbency of each material. Which material would make a good coat or umbrella? Can you explain how you know?
