Our learning this half term will focus on why three British Queens are significant and should be remembered in History, animal lifecycles and how to keep our bodies healthy in Science and designing and making our own nutritious wrap in DT

Here are some optional home learning tasks for you to complete during the next 6 weeks. They are all related to our current learning and will give you an opportunity to explore and enrich the learning we do in school. We would love you to share your work with us by bringing it into school or by sharing photos, videos or activities using Class Dojo.

Supermarket Sweep!

Visit a supermarket or look at the food at home. Can you find out where the food has come from? Make a list of the different places and see if you can find them on an atlas, globe or google maps online. Think and talk about how food arrives at the supermarket from its place of origin.

Food and Exercise Diary

In class, we are learning about what keeps our bodies fit and healthy. Try to keep a food and exercise diary for a week to explore what you do to look after your body. Think about which food groups you are eating from and create your own 'Eatwell Plate'

Life Cycles

In Science, we are learning about life cycles. Choose your favourite animal and create a representation of its life cycle. You could create a poster, fact file or mini book. You should show the different stages of the life cycle in order, using pictures and labels to identify each stage.

Family Tree

How are Queen Victoria and Queen Elizabeth II related? Can you create their family tree using images and information you can find from books and the internet? How creative can you be?

Create a model, draw or a create poster in the style of an estate agent advertising one of the Royal Houses from the reign of one of our three queens.

Queen Elizabeth I, Queen Victoria and Queen Elizabeth II sat for hundreds of portraits during their reigns. Can you create one more? Draw a portrait of one of the Queens. Look carefully at their facial features and clothing. What style will you create it in or which artist will you be inspired by?
