## YEAR 6



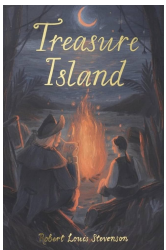
### THE SUMMER TERM BEGINS!

Dear Parents & Carers,

Welcome back to the Summer term in Year 6. We can't quite believe we are already in the Summer Term! We've got lots planned this term, including preparing to take our National Curriculum tests, carrying on with our exciting theme learning, a trip to Lincoln Cathedral, and our trip to PGL! Also, this term will see us preparing for our new starts at Secondary school, including transition visits from secondary school tutors and a day/days visiting our new schools in July. Arrangements for Year 6 will stay much the same during the this term, with Miss Chadwick teaching Monday to Wednesday and Miss Righton teaching on Thursdays and Fridays. Mrs Handforth will continue to work with our class and we have welcomed Mrs Carlin back to work with us too!



### ENGLISH:



This term, we will be studying the classic novel, *Treasure Island*. Through close read analysis, regular whole class reading, and a focus on grammatical and authorial features, we will study this novel in depth to further develop our reading skills. Alongside this, we will also continue to revise and recap our grammar, punctuation and spelling skills as preparation for our National Curriculum tests which take place in May. We will work on applying these skills to develop our writing technique.

### MATHS:

Our Maths learning will cover the following areas: properties of shape, position & direction, problem solving and investigation work. Our arithmetic skills will continue to be a focus as we improve our accuracy and fluency of the different calculations we've learnt. We will also be revising lots of our prior learning to strengthen our reasoning skills.

### SCIENCE:

In the first part of the summer term, we will be learning about the human circulatory system, including how the human heart works, the components of blood and how we can keep our body healthy with exercise. In the second half of the term, we will be working on developing our scientific skills by testing sunglasses and their light and UV transmissions.

## **HISTORY:**

History will be our focus in Summer Term 1 where we will be exploring the theme 'Who should go on the £10 banknote?' We will learn about some of the famous people who have been on bank notes discuss other historically significant individuals.

## **GEOGRAPHY:**

Our Geography focus in Summer Term 2 will be on undertaking a fieldwork enquiry. We will analyse issues in our local area and plan and undertake fieldwork.

## **RE:**

In RE this term, we will be trialling a new Unit from the Lincolnshire Locally Agreed Syllabus 2025. It will focus on Inspirational Women who have impacted their societies throughout History. We begin by looking at Christianity and Anne Askew. We will later explore Paganism and Philosophy by looking at the Ancient Egyptian, Hypatia. We will complete the unit by looking at Islam and a current, Iranian lady called Shirin Ebadi.

## **PSHE:**

In PSHE we will be studying two main themes: '*Relationships*' and '*Changing Me*'. Relationships will focus on knowing how to make friends and how to solve friendship problems when they occur. It will also look at friendships online and keeping safe. The second theme will look at self-image and puberty.

## **COMPUTING:**

Our Summer Term's computing will be focussing on extending our knowledge of 'Big Data' from early on in the year, looking at how we use data and how we can make our school even more tech friendly. Our second theme will be on inventing a product so the children will explore the design process to make a computer-aided product.

## **PE:**

In Year 6, the children continue to have PE on Wednesday and Thursday. We will cover a range of PE options throughout the term, including Rounders, OAA, and Athletics.

## **FRENCH:**

We will be studying '*Moi Dans Le Monde*', where we will learn about different Francophone countries and some of their customs & celebrations. We will also learn how to say what we can do to protect our planet.

In our final term, we will consolidate our French knowledge ready for moving on to our future Secondary Schools.

## **MUSIC:**

Our musical focus will be on composing a song inspired by our time at St Anne's. We will identify and evaluate musical features of a song before working in groups to contribute ideas to a verse.
